SW Division Street Road Closure 7AM to 6PM Tuesday August 18, and from Friday August 21 to Friday September 4

This notice is to inform you that SW Division Street west of SW Main Street will be closed from 7:00AM to 6:00PM for the construction of storm sewer within SW Division Street/SW Main Street intersection on Tuesday August 18. Since passage to and from homes on SW Division Street west of SW Main Street during this day will be extremely difficult, please park any vehicle that you would need to use on this day in a parking space on a nearby street on Monday to ensure usage of your vehicle.

Please work with the construction crew for safe pedestrian passage through the work zone.

Emergency access to local residents will be maintained.

SW Division Street will be reopened at the end of the day on Tuesday and will remain open through Thursday August 20 at which time you will once again need to park needed vehicles outside of SW Division Street west of SW Main Street.

This second closure will be from 7:00AM to 6:00PM Friday August 21 to Friday September 4. There will be no parking within this section of SW Division Street right-of-way during this timeframe. Therefore all vehicles will either need to be parked on private property or along a different street. It is necessary to keep the right-of-way clear of vehicles during this time for the construction of the new storm sewer. Vehicles parked within this section of the SW Division street right-of-way during this time period are subject to be towed.

The City regrets any inconvenience the temporary road closure may cause and appreciates your patience with this construction work.
