CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE DOWNTOWN INTERSECTION
MONUMENT REMOVAL STUDY

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Sherwood is seeking proposals from qualified consultants to evaluate the safety of three intersections in Downtown Sherwood and develop options for eliminating site distance issues caused by the large concrete monuments located in each corner. Once the existing conditions have been evaluated the consultant will work with City staff to develop bookend options that satisfy community goals and prepare preliminary cost estimates for consideration by elected officials. The City will then select a preferred option and supplement the current budget so the project can begin next spring. Once the funding has been approved the consultant will prepare construction plans, specifications, an engineer's estimate, and assist with bidding. The study will likely require professional engineering services for the intersection safety components and lighting, and may require structural engineering services to evaluate impacts to the existing light pole foundations.

A pre-proposal meeting will NOT be held for this request. Consultant selection shall be based on Qualification Based Selection (QBS) criteria only (OAR 731-148-0010). Proposals containing information on fees, rates or pricing shall be disqualified. The City of Sherwood may cancel this RFP or reject all proposals if determined to be in the best interest of the City.
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
