

Census Data for Community Analysis Workshop @ Sherwood Public Library

Want to make more data-driven decisions for your business or organization? Join us at Sherwood Public Library on November 4th for this morning workshop on using Census data for community analysis to help you capture key demographic, social, economic and housing indicators that define our community. Learn how to access data for small-area geographics, such as Zip Codes and Census Tracts through hands-on activities and a presentation from Linda Clark, the Data Dissemination Specialist for the Census Bureau in Oregon.



Workshop participants will:

- Access neighborhood-level data to create Community Profiles.
- Obtain the most recent data on age, income, poverty, race/ethnicity, and other measures using American Community Survey (ACS) yearly released data.

This session is timed to fit around your busy work day and will be especially helpful for business owners, community leaders, educators, planners and anyone looking to use data to understand the community.
