

**TREES REQUESTED TO BE
REMOVED**

BEHIND 15093 SW SMOCK STREET / SNYDER PARK

Apple Tree – this green apple tree has apples falling in to our Park Neighbors back yard and their dog is eating these apples and getting sick. Area is irrigated and a new tree can be replanted quickly.

Our Arborist report states that the tree canopy hangs more than 10 feet into the neighbors back yard . The only way to keep apples out of their yard is to constantly prune this tree back to the fence line or remove it to the ground.









SNYDER PARK ACROSS FROM PLAYGROUND

This Cherry Tree is sitting across from the playground and next to the story rock circle.

This tree is a forty-five foot Cherry tree with a trunk of 38 inches. The tree is in very poor health. The structure of the tree is poor due to several large dead trunks and limbs. There is advanced dieback throughout the trees canopy. Cherry trees have a life span of approximately 50-80 Years old and this tree is approximately 80 years old. Due to the age of the tree, the amount and size of the dead limbs and the advance decline of the trees health, our Arborist recommends the tree be removed for the safety to persons and property.







OREGON STREET ROUND A BOUT

In the Round a bout there are 3 Birch trees . Two of them have been infested by Bronze Birch Borer as well as damaged by Sap Suckers , the combination of the insects and Birds has killed 2 of the 3 trees.

Our Arborist recommends removing two of the three trees and replacing them with different species such as Beech, Columnar Oak, or Katsura.
