## Sherwood Transportation System Plan Update

**Public Notice** is hereby given that the **City of Sherwood Planning Commission** is scheduled to hold a public hearing on the matter below on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 at 7PM. The public hearing will be held at City Hall, 22560 SW Pine Street, Sherwood, OR 97140.

**Proposal:** The City of Sherwood is updating the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP) to address community needs and regional requirements. The TSP provides a framework for the long-term vision of Sherwood's transportation system and includes strategies and planned improvement projects for a variety of travel modes (pedestrian, bike, auto, and transit). In addition to addressing local needs, the proposal includes updating the plan so that it is consistent with state and regional policies, such as the Oregon Transportation Plan (OTP), Metro's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), Metro's Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP), and complement other local plans, such as the Washington County TSP.

Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision-maker and the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue will preclude appeal, on said issue.
