WHAT IS ACCEPTED:

- Expired or unwanted prescription medications
- Unneeded over-the-counter medicines & vitamins
- Drugs that didn't work for you, a family member, or pet
- Drugs that are no longer used
- Medicine from deceased family members
- Unknown tablets and capsules
- Ointments and liquid medication in *leak proof* containers ONLY

**LEAVE ALL MEDICINES IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINERS
IF POSSIBLE**

Please do NOT bring thermometers, needles, medical waste of any type, hydrogen peroxide, aerosol cans, inhalers or EpiPens.
