

## Definitions

"**Motor Truck**" means a motor vehicle that is primarily designed or used for carrying loads other than passengers and that has either (A) three or more axles, or (B) a registration weight exceeding 20,000 pounds. The term "motor truck" includes a combination vehicle consisting of a truck tractor and one or more truck trailers.

"**Registration Weight**" means the loaded weight required under ORS 803.430 to be declared and established as the maximum loaded weight at which certain vehicles may be operated on public roads.

## Liability

In addition to any penalty that may be imposed under this ordinance, the owner and driver of a motor truck using a road in violation of this Chapter shall be jointly and severally liable to the City for all damages done as a result of the violation.

Some streets have signage, which alert drivers that trucks are prohibited; however, driving a truck on any street not designated as a truck route is a violation of the municipal code unless you are operating under an exemption.

*It is a violation of Sherwood Municipal Code to operate a Motor Truck upon any street that is not designated as a Truck Route.*

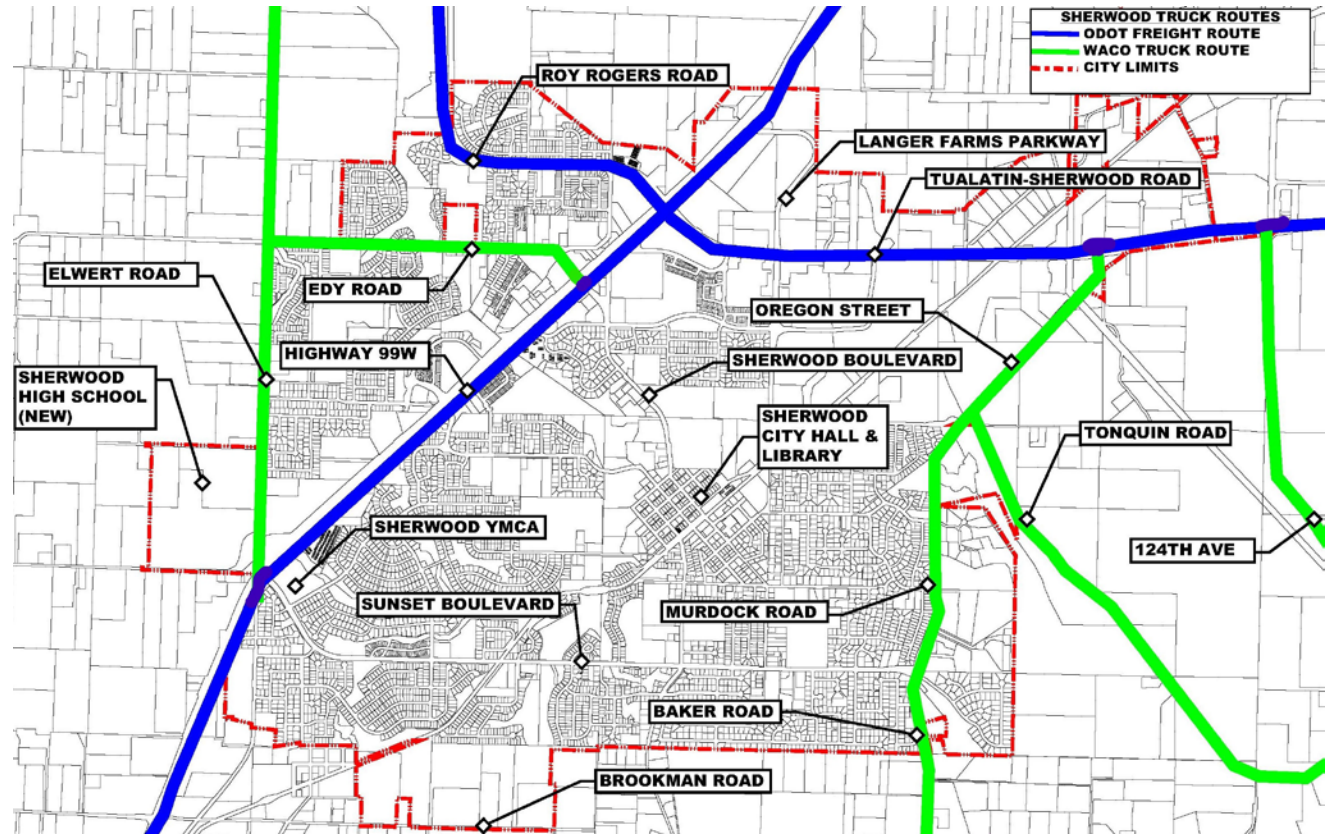
**10.20.020 Truck Operation on Designated Routes.**

Except as provided in Section 10.020.030, no person shall operate any motor truck upon any street within the City unless designated as a truck route under Section 10.20.040

**Other Enforcement**

**10.20.070 Weigh-in.** Any peace officer may require a person moving or driving a truck on a road other than a truck route to proceed to any available public or private scale for the purpose of weighing the truck.

 **SMC 10.08.030** restricts trucks from parking for a period of greater than 30 minutes between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. within the city limits.



**Designated Truck Routes**

- Oregon State Highway 99W (Pacific Highway)
- SW Roy Rogers Road
- SW Tualatin Sherwood Road
- SW Oregon Street between SW Tualatin Sherwood Rd & SW Tonquin Rd.
- SW Murdock Road
- SW Baker Road
- SW Elwert Road (pursuant to Washington County designation)
- SW Edy Road (pursuant to Washington County designation)

**Exemptions**

- Trucks owned by federal, state or local government while being used for a public purpose
- Emergency Vehicles
- Trucks following a City approved detour
- Trucks making local deliveries

**Violations**

A violation of this code is a Class B traffic violation under the **SMC** and **ORS 811.450**
