#### Entrepreneurship: An Economic & Community Driver

- They create a significant share of jobs: Nearly all net new job creation in the past 25 years came from startups. <u>Kauffman</u> <u>Foundation Study</u>.
- They're diverse: Latinos, Asians, and immigrants more than doubled their rate of entrepreneurship from 1996-2016.
- They're intentional: 87% of new entrepreneurs are opportunity driven.
- They're age agnostic: Entrepreneurs are equally divided among the four major age groups from 20-64.

- TiE Oregon is the local chapter of TiE Global, a nonprofit founded in 1992 in Silicon Valley by successful entrepreneurs with roots in the Indian subcontinent.
- Mission: Foster entrepreneurship globally through funding, mentoring, networking and education.
- Mission: Inclusivity and supporting entrepreneurs of all backgrounds, in all industries, at all stages.
- TiE Oregon has successfully built on the global TiE mission, with locally focused programs for underserved entrepreneurs.
- ► The organization's diversity credentials are strong:
  - ▶ TiE Oregon's Board has 62% women and 54% are from diverse populations.
  - The TiE Oregon Foundation Board is 67% women and 50% from diverse populations. TiE Oregon's staff is 55% women and 36% POC.


