

2019 Pavement Overlay Projects Pre-Bid Meeting Agenda

<u>Schedule</u>

- 1. Introduction and sign in.
- 2. Pregualification required by **Tuesday**, **July 30**, **2019** at 5:00PM (PDT).
- 3. Work hours are from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday.
- 4. No work on Saturday or Sunday without written approval from the City.
- 5. SW Main Street, SW Ladd Hill Road and SW Galbreath Drive shall have two lanes open to traffic at all times unless flaggers are provided for a single lane closure. Lane closure may only occur between the hours of 8:30AM to 4:30PM with the exception of SW Ladd Hill Road closure for the cement treatment of the west lane of SW Ladd Hill Road (See Contract Drawings).
- Contractor to coordinate work schedule and road closure schedule with city project manager 2 weeks in advance so that city can put news on website and put up reader boards.
- 7. The driveway at 14270 SW Galbreath Drive is the only driveway access to the active business. Contractor may only close one half of the driveway at a time during construction to maintain business access. Contract to coordinate with owner at least 7 days in advance.
- 8. Emergency access, mail service, trash service (Friday) and school buses access shall be maintained at all times.
- Contractor shall contact all affected property owners at least 3 days in advance of any work which will affect access to their property or rerouting (SW Brookman Road intersection closure). Detour signage and plan required.
- 10. The contractor may use city property for staging at SW Columbia Street. Contractor to clean and restore property to original condition.

- 11. Anticipated start date of August 19, 2019. All work to be completed by **October 4, 2019**.
- 12. No construction surveying is being provided by the city. Since surveying was not obtained for the design of the project. A CAD drawing can be provided, however it is based upon aerial topography. The contractor shall supply the City with field as-built plan notes at the end of the project.
- 13. Trench pumping, if necessary, will be pumped into a sediment bag placed at a city approved location.
- 14. It is the contractor's responsibility to restore disturbed surrounding property to equal or better condition.
- 15. Contractor to obtain Railroad, Washington County and Clackamas County permit for performing work in their jurisdictional right-of-way. Insurance and traffic control plan required to obtain permit.

- 17. It is the bidder's responsibility to check the City of Sherwood's Website for upcoming Addendum pertaining to this project.
