Plans:

Revised plans have been issued for 1 sheet. The plan sheet changes are summarized below.

Woodhaven Park Phase 2 Plan Set

Sheet Number	Description of Change
EC2	Temporary Chainlink Fence Location to encompass the playground.

Additional plan clarifications:

Revise sheet L3.3 – Irrigation plan as follows: Provide temporary irrigation for shrubs along eastern property line (480 LF). Temporary irrigation to include drip control zone kits (hunter or approved equal), valve connected to mainline, lateral line, pressure reducing valve, drip line (hunter PLD or approved equal). **Note:** No updated plan sheet is provided.

Revise sheet L1.2 plant legend. Change WILDFLOWERS quantities from square feet to the following: ASCLEPIAS TUBEROSA - 99 plants, MIMULUS CARDINALIS – 69 plants, ANTENNARIA DIOICA – 125 plants, LUPINUS RIVULARIS – 103 plants, ECHINACEA PURPUREA – 144 plants. **Note:** No updated plan sheet is provided.

Specifications:

Specification Revision #1 - 01095.10 (f) Rock Climbing Wall – first bullet revise sheet number reference to C6.2.

Specification Revision #2 - 01095.10 (g) Play Slide – second bullet revise sheet number reference to C6.1.

Question: Is the contractor responsible for installing the 'new pole' near the basketball

court? If so, are there material specs for the pole?

Response: Yes, see specification section 01095.10(p) Cameras.

Question: Is the contractor responsible for anything related to procuring and/or installing

the digital sign? If so, are there specs or vendors identified?

PRE-CONSTRUCTION, CLEARING, AND DEMOLITION NOTES:


- 1. ALL BASE ESC MEASURES (INLET PROTECTION, PERIMETER SEDIMENT CONTROL, GRAVEL CONSTRUCTION, ENTRANCES, ETC.) MUST BE IN PLACE, FUNCTIONAL, AND APPROVED IN AN INITIAL INSPECTION, PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES.
- 2. SEDIMENT BARRIERS APPROVED FOR USE INCLUDE <u>SEDIMENT FENCE</u>, <u>BERMS CONSTRUCTED OUT OF MULCH</u>, CHIPPINGS, OR OTHER SUITABLE MATERIAL STRAW WATERS, OR OTHER APPROVED <u>MATERIALS</u>.
- 3. SENSITIVE RESOURCES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, TREES, WETLANDS, AND RIPARIAN PROTECTION AREAS SHALL BE CLEARLY DELINEATED WITH ORANGE CONSTRUCTION FENCING OR CHAIN LINK FENCING IN A MANNER THAT IS CLEARLY VISIBLE TO ANYONE IN THE AREA. NO ACTIVITIES ARE PERMITTED TO OCCUR BEYOND THE CONSTRUCTION BARRIER.
- 4. CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCES SHALL BE INSTALLED AT THE BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTAINED FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT. ADDITIONAL MEASURES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, STREET SWEEPING, AND VACUUMING, MAY BE REQUIRED TO INSURE THAT ALL PAVED AREAS ARE KEPT CLEAN FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT.
- 5, RUN-ON AND RUN-OFF CONTROLS SHALL BE IN PLACE AND FUNCTIONING PRIOR TO BEGINNING SUBSTANTIAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. RUN-ON AND RUN-OFF CONTROL MEASURES INCLUDE: SLOPE DRAINS (WITH OUTLET PROTECTION), CHECK DAMS, SURFACE ROUGHENING, AND BANK STABILIZATION.
- NOTE: PRE-DEVELOPED RUN-OFF SHEET FLOWS EASTERLY INTO ON-SITE DRAINAGE AND NORTHERLY ONTO ADJACENT PROPERTIES.

THESE EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLANS ASSUME "DRY WEATHER" CONSTRUCTION. "WET WEATHER" CONSTRUCTION MEASURES NEED TO BE APPLIED BETWEEN OCTOBER 1ST AND MAY 31ST.






