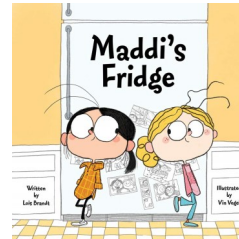

*(Think of other body parts you can move!)*

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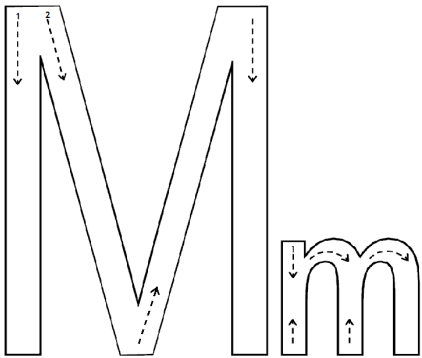


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## Play
