Application for Street Tree Removal Permit
(Type I Land Use Review)**

Approval may be granted to remove a street tree provided that the owner and applicant comply with other provisions of this Code. Street tree removal permits shall be subject to the requirements of Section 16.142.060.B. Street trees that are removed must be replaced by the owner/ applicant unless the City of Sherwood has authorized a replacement tree per section 16.142.060.D.

Tree replacement

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Reason for removing the street tree:

Street trees that are removed must be replaced unless an exemption is granted per section 16.142.050.D of the development code.

I further acknowledge that;

- I have read the code criteria
- I understand that a root barrier is required for all new street trees.
- I must receive written approval from the planning department prior to removing the street tree(s) in question,
- I will submit a report from a certified arborist at my expense if it is required,
- I will place a ribbon or other identifier on the street tree(s) in question for the planning department to identify the tree and to place a sign next to the tree for a ten day period,
- I will replace the street tree(s) within six (6) months of the date of removal at my expense.

To be submitted with the Application:

Submit the following:

- Fee:** \$25 for 1st tree and \$10 for each additional tree
- Plan:** Submit a diagram or photograph showing the location of the tree in relation to the planter strip, other trees, street, sidewalk, house, etc.
- Arborist Report:** If trees are over 10” DBH or an exemption from replacement if requested. Note: if exemption is requested for smaller trees an arborists report may be required.
- Statement:** If trees are over 10” DBH a statement discussing whether and how the applicant sought out assistance from the HOA, neighbors or the city to retain the tree.
