

UNREGULATED CONTAMINATES—ADDENDUM

Due to late reporting from Wilsonville the following contaminants were not included in the original Water Quality Report for 2014. Please include the following information with the previously released report.

Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule 3 (UCMR3) Sampling

The UCMR3 is a requirement set by the EPA for public water systems to monitor for a list of 21 currently unregulated contaminants. Unregulated contaminants are those that don't yet have a drinking water standard set by USEPA. The purpose of monitoring for these contaminants is to help EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a standard and to set a Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL).
