Roll Call/Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 5:34 P.M. by Chair Christine McLaughlin.

Approval of Minutes

Motion to approve the October minutes was made by Christine McLaughlin, seconded by Colin Woodbury, and approved unanimously.

Library Manager's Report

- Adrienne Doman Calkins reviewed monthly Management Report for October 2014. See attached report.
- The library was a trick-or-treating site during the Main Street Halloween event. This
 marked the first year that the library has participated. Door counts saw a significant
 increase during the event, between the hours of 3-5 PM the library saw 844 people.
- Statistics from the new 3M e-book app were shared. Sherwood saw a 316% increase in 3M checkouts from September to October, the second largest increase among WCCLS libraries.

Library Business & News

The Board agreed unanimously that Chair McLaughlin may continue serving as Chair next year. McLaughlin is willing to continue serving as Chair but will confer with Vice-Chair Christie before accepting the role.

Adrienne reviewed the 2014 Partnerships, Outreach, National & International Programming, Donors document. See document attached.

Adrienne shared that the Art of the Story grand finale may be held in Sherwood at the new Community Cultural Arts Center. The Library would like to partner with Main Street and make this an event that will benefit all Old Town businesses.

The library is in the process of partnering with Rotary to fund a storytelling series for adults in 2015.

Adrienne gave an overview of the StORytime Partner initiative. StORytime is a statewide early literacy publicity campaign from the Governor's Office.

The next Board meeting will be on Wednesday, February 18, 2015 in the Sherwood Library & City Hall, Conference Room A.
