

## **RESOLUTION 2010-014**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE LEASING OF POLICE VEHICLES

**WHEREAS**, The duly elected governing body of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, having been presented with information about the need for additional options for the procurement of police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, The Sherwood City Council hereby resolves that the State of Oregon Department of Administrative Services provides a viable option for the procurement of police vehicles through its Motor Vehicle Lease Program and thereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Inter-governmental agreement with the State of Oregon for the procurement of police vehicles.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, with the State of Oregon,

<u>Section 2.</u> Effective Date: Upon obtaining required signatures on agreement.
