



RESOLUTION 2010-014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE LEASING OF POLICE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, The duly elected governing body of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, having been presented with information about the need for additional options for the procurement of police vehicles; and


WHEREAS, The Sherwood City Council hereby resolves that the State of Oregon Department of Administrative Services provides a viable option for the procurement of police vehicles through its Motor Vehicle Lease Program and thereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Inter-governmental agreement with the State of Oregon for the procurement of police vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, with the State of Oregon,

Section 2. Effective Date: Upon obtaining required signatures on agreement.
