

RESOLUTION 2010-037

ESTABLISHING A FEE IN THE CITY'S FEE SCHEDULE PERTAINING TO AN APPEAL PROCESS FOR BUILDING CODE VIOLATIONS AS AUTHORIZED BY SENATE BILL 915

WHEREAS, Oregon Senate Bill 915, relating to enforcement of building codes, allows municipalities to impose a fee for an Appeals Process for violations of State Building Codes; and

WHEREAS, the Sherwood Municipal Code (2.32.010) authorizes certain administrative fees and charges to be established by Resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing to receive testimony on the adoption of Ordinance 2010-012, adopting the amended Senate Bill 915 and needs to establish a fee in the City's Fee Schedule to comply with said Senate Bill.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A fee of \$250.00 is hereby established as the fee for an Appeal Process.

<u>Section 2:</u> The fee established by this Resolution shall be effective the date of this resolution adoption.
