

RESOLUTION 2009-061

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO CONSTRUCT THE SW 2ND STREET PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City solicited Bids based upon competitive bidding processes meeting the requirements of the City and State Contracting Rules; and

WHEREAS, the City received four (4) Bids that were publicly opened on July 21, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City reviewed the Bids and selected the lowest Responsive Bid submitted by Kodiak Pacific Construction in the amount of \$80,951.00; and

WHEREAS; staff recommends establishing a contingency amount of \$12,142.65 (15% of the total construction costs) to cover unforeseen construction issues and differing site conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> To award a contract for the construction of SW 2nd Street Pavement Rehabilitation Project to Kodiak Pacific Construction. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Kodiak Pacific Construction for a maximum of \$80,951.00 for construction of the SW 2nd Street Pavement Rehabilitation Project.

<u>Section 2:</u> The City Council approves a maximum construction contingency amount of \$12,142.65 (15% of the total construction cost).

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
