

RESOLUTION 2022-063

RECOMMENDING LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES TO LEAGUE OF OREGON CITIES FOR THE 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

WHEREAS, the League of Oregon Cities (LOC) establishes policy committees in the year prior to the regular session of the Oregon legislature; and

WHEREAS, the policy committees develop a range of legislative objectives for consideration by the member cities of the LOC; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood is a member of the LOC and has been requested to provide its top five (5) priorities from a list of twenty-nine (29) legislative priorities developed by the seven policy committees; and

WHEREAS, the Sherwood City Council reviewed the list of legislative priorities prior to a Council work session that was held on July 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS, members of the Sherwood City Council came to a consensus of their top five (5) during the Council work session; and

WHEREAS, the consensus from the work session was that were the top five (5) priorities of the City of Sherwood are: Full Funding and Alignment for State Land Use Initiatives, Lodging Tax Flexibility, Digital Equity and Inclusion, Incentives for Broadband Affordability, Adoption and Consumer Protections, and Transportation Safety Enhancements.

WHEREAS, with the passage of this resolution, the requested ballot from the LOC will be submitted by the City Manager indicating this information; and

WHEREAS, the LOC Board of Directors will utilize there submitted priorities along with input from other member cities to develop the League of Oregon Cities 2023 legislative priorities agenda;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby directed to submit a legislative priorities ballot to the League of Oregon Cities indication the top five (5) priorities of the City of Sherwood are: Full Funding and Alignment for State Land Use Initiatives, Lodging Tax Flexibility, Digital Equity and Inclusion, Incentives for Broadband Affordability, Adoption and Consumer Protections, and Transportation Safety Enhancements.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
