

RESOLUTION 2023-025

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKLINE, INC. FOR THE 2023-24 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City has a responsibility to maintain the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City partnered with the City of Hillsboro to include Sherwood's 2023-24 Slurry Seal program in their RFP for the same services; and

WHEREAS, the RFP process identified Blackline, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackline, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$165,944.39.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract change order(s) for a total amount not to exceed 10% of the original award (\$16,594.44) for a total contract amount not to exceed \$182,538.83.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption
