



RESOLUTION 2023-041

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADOPT THE WASHINGTON COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTION NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation is any sustained action that reduces or eliminates long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards and their effects; and

WHEREAS, Washington County, its cities and special districts understand that proactive steps should be taken where possible to protect the economy and most vulnerable citizens from inevitable natural hazard events; and

WHEREAS, Washington County, along with local jurisdictions started the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (NHMP) project which reviews and evaluates local area risk factors specific to Sherwood that may arise from various types of natural hazards; and


WHEREAS, the NHMP will be a useful tool for increasing awareness about hazards and risks in Sherwood while providing options and resources to reduce those risks.
