NOTICE: Notice is hereby given to anyone who testified verbally, in writing, or submitted a public testimony form at the Planning Commission or City Council hearing on these matters, that on February 18, 2014 the Sherwood City Council adopted Ordinance 2014-004 which approved an amendment to the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP) to extend SW Langer Farms Parkway north of Highway 99W and to the west.

The council also adopted Ordinance 2014-005 which approved an amendment to the TSP to extend SW Baler Street partially as a collector and partially as a local street north and east of Tualatin-Sherwood Road.

The findings made to reach the decision are in an attachment to the Ordinance and are available for review at the City and on the City's web site at www.sherwoodoregon.gov. The decision of the City Council is the final local decision.
