**Public Notice** is hereby given that the **Sherwood City Council** will conduct a public hearing on the matter below on **Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at 7:00 PM** at the Sherwood City Hall Community Room, 22560 SW Pine St, Sherwood, Oregon, on the following land use matter:

**Proposal:** The City of Sherwood is updating the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP) to address community needs and regional requirements. The TSP provides a framework for the long-term vision of Sherwood's transportation system and includes strategies and planned improvement projects for a variety of travel modes (pedestrian, bike, auto, and transit). In addition to addressing local needs, the proposal includes updating the plan so that it is consistent with state and regional policies, such as the Oregon Transportation Plan (OTP), Metro's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), Metro's Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP), and to complement other local plans such as the Washington County TSP.

Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker and parties an opportunity to respond to the issue will preclude appeal, on said issue.
