We have reviewed the site plan for the above – mentioned project. The site plan shows one enclosure on the property measuring 10' deep and 20' wide, which allows for straight on access.

The other details on the site plan are not shown. These requirements will need to be met to ensure our access:


- The gates need to be hinged in front of the enclosure walls to allow for the full 20' width. This will also allow for the 120 degree opening angle that is required.
- No center post at the gate access point.
- The gates need cane bolts and holes put in place for the gates to be locked in the open and closed position. The holes for the gates to be held open need to be at the full 120 degree opening angle.
- There must be 25' of overhead clearance.

This approval letter is approved based on site plans received as of the date of this letter, we require additional approval if any changes are made after this date.

16.98.020 - Solid Waste and Recycling Storage

All uses shall provide solid waste and recycling storage receptacles which are adequately sized to accommodate all solid waste generated on site. All solid waste and recycling storage areas and family, commercial, industrial and institutional uses shall be screened by six (6) foot high sightreceptacles shall be located out of public view. Solid waste and recycling receptacles for multiobscuring fence or masonry wall and shall be easily accessible to collection vehicles.

entrance (western driveway) on SW Blake Street and through the secured staff parking area, passage to the Flash Mix, Flow Split, and Flocculation Building. Access to the enclosure area will be via the primary Plans (Exhibit A, Sheets B-028 and B-029). The enclosure will be a minimum 6 feet high by 10 feet deep which will be granted by WTP staff. More than 75 feet of unobstructed access that is required by Pride Response: The proposed waste and recycling storage enclosure will be adjacent to the Flash Mix, Flow from public view given its location beyond the security fence between the Administration Building and gates, consistent with Pride Disposal & Recycling standards. The enclosure area will also be obscured Split, and Flocculation Building and the staff parking area, as shown in the Transportation/Circulation by 20 feet wide, with CMU side walls and concrete back wall (against basin) and full-width chain link Disposal & Recycling in front of the enclosure will be provided, based on dimensions noted in the Transportation/Circulation Plan. Therefore, this standard is met.
