- Statewide Planning Goals: Goal 1-Citizen Involvement, Goal 2-Land Use Planning, Goal 10-Housing, and Goal 12 Transportation

Public Participation

Oregon Law typically requires the City to permit any person to appear in person to ask questions or comment on public hearing matters. However, due to COVID-19 restrictions, persons interested in participating may provide written comments at least 24 hours in advance of a hearing by emailing changi@sherwoodoregon.gov

An email submitted must clearly state that it is intended as testimony for a public hearing, the specific public hearing topic for which it is intended and must be received at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled meeting time. Or, testimoney can be submitted to the Planning Department, City Hall, located at 22560 SW Pine Street, Sherwood, OR 97140. For comments to be considered and addressed within the staff report, please submit comments by Friday, February 25, 2022.

In addition, the Planning Commission will set aside time to permit the public to add comments during the hearing.

During the live Planning Commission meeting, community comments on non-hearing items and public hearing testimony can be given by phone. To participate via phone, please call or email Joy Chang at 503-625-4214 or changi@sherwoodoregon.gov by 5:00 PM on Monday, March 7, 2022 to receive the phone dial-in instructions.

Public testimony should be limited to the findings of fact in the Staff Report, the above criteria, or other City or State applicable land use standards. **Only those persons who provide testimony may appeal the decision**. Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision-maker and the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue will preclude appeal, on said issue, to the Appeal Authority or State Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).
