2.10.010 - Board established. A police advisory board, hereinafter referred to as the "board," is established for the purposes of assisting the police department, establish priorities for the delivery of police services, including types, levels and quality of police services, the police department's strategic plan and goal, recommended strategies for the future and a public policy on policing. The board and its members must be impartial and unbiased. The city council encourages the board to seek opportunities to educate the community about police work and the purpose of law enforcement.
