

The City of Sherwood is building
a pedestrian bridge over
Highway 99W between the
high school and the YMCA.

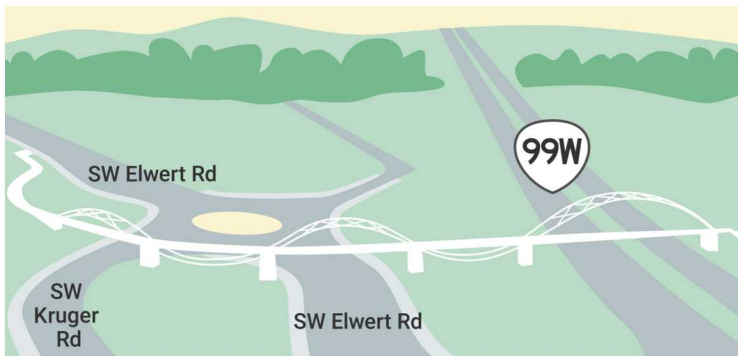


We're building a better, safer way for people biking and walking to cross Hwy 99W. The 900-foot long bicycle and pedestrian bridge will cross over the highway just north of the intersection of Sunset Boulevard/Elwert Road, between the Sherwood Family YMCA and Sherwood High School.

Road closures will occur on three different weekends this winter/spring 2025.

Hwy 99W is scheduled* to close from **Friday, March 7 at 9 p.m.** through **Monday, March 10 at 5 a.m.** to install the arch span over the highway.

We will return to install the four bridge spans on the west side of Hwy 99W—over Elwert Road, over Kruger Road, and the two greenspaces—later this spring.

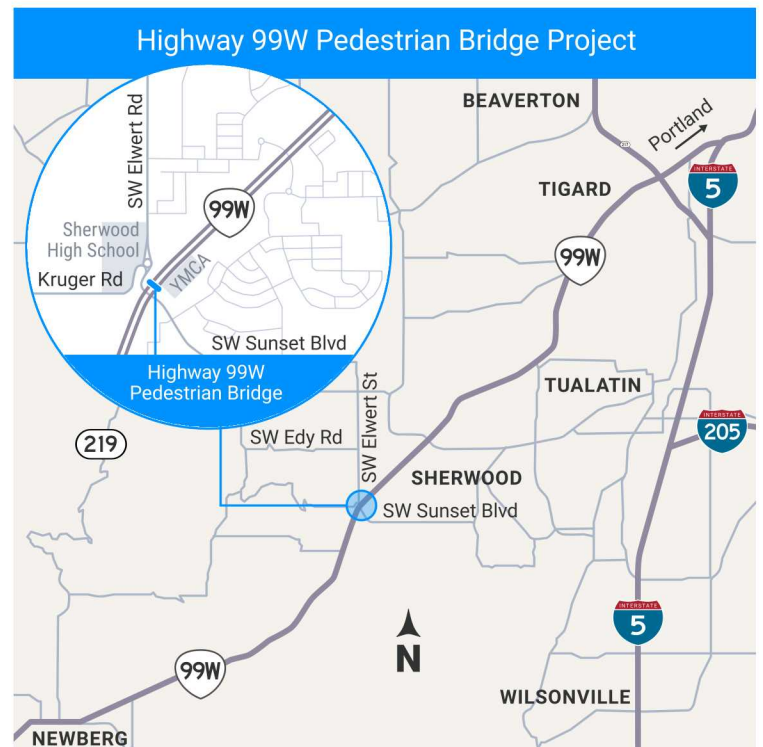


Bridge illustration showing the five spans

*The Hwy 99W closure weekend is not fully confirmed yet because PGE utility relocation work in early 2025 will determine the construction start date. We'll fully confirm the date two weeks before the highway closure. Inclement weather such as high winds, snow, or ice may delay the scheduled work, as well.

Detour Information

Expect traffic delays. Check the webpage for the most up-to-date schedule information. Digital message signs will be posted on the highway and Elwert Road two weeks prior to each road closure.

Detour Information

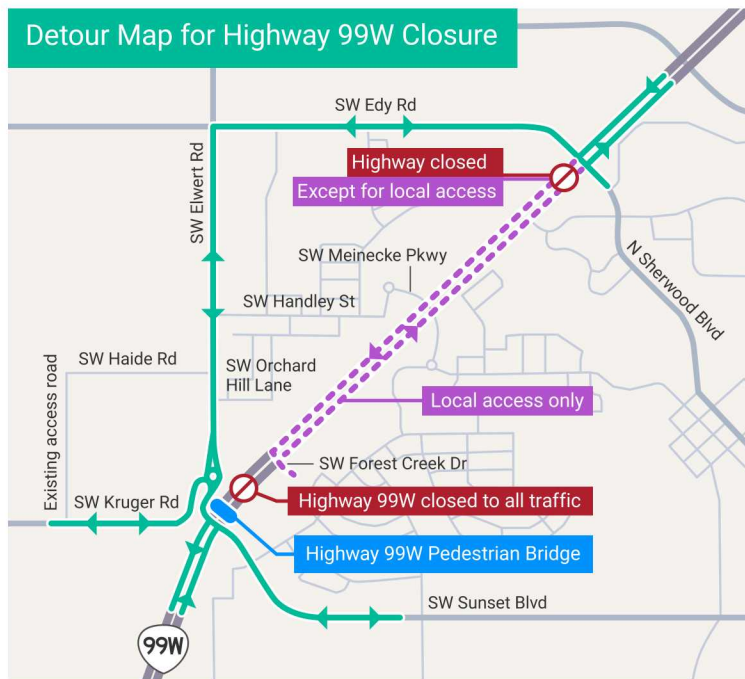
Highway 99W will be closed in Sherwood while crews will place the pedestrian bridge arch over the highway.

Planned weekend closure: March 7–10

The full closure of Highway 99W will occur between SW Edy Road and SW Sunset Boulevard.

- Northbound detour: SW Elwert Road to SW Edy Road back to 99W.
- Southbound detour: SW Edy Road to SW Elwert Road back to 99W.
- Flaggers will be working 24 hours a day at the intersection of SW Elwert Road and SW Edy Road.

We'll maintain local access for residents/businesses located within the closed highway section.



Bridge construction timeline

- March 2024: Groundbreaking.
- March–May 2025: Bridge span installation over the course of three weekend road closures.
- Spring and summer 2025: Crews install bridge deck, lighting, railings and approach ramps near YMCA.
- Early fall 2025: Expected completion and grand opening event.

Crews began construction in March 2024. Construction will continue through early fall 2025, concluding with a grand opening event to celebrate the new bridge.

Elwert Road and Kruger Road will be closed for a weekend in late March.

Crews will place the pedestrian bridge arch span over Elwert Road and the inverted arch span over the greenspace between Hwy 99W and the roundabout.

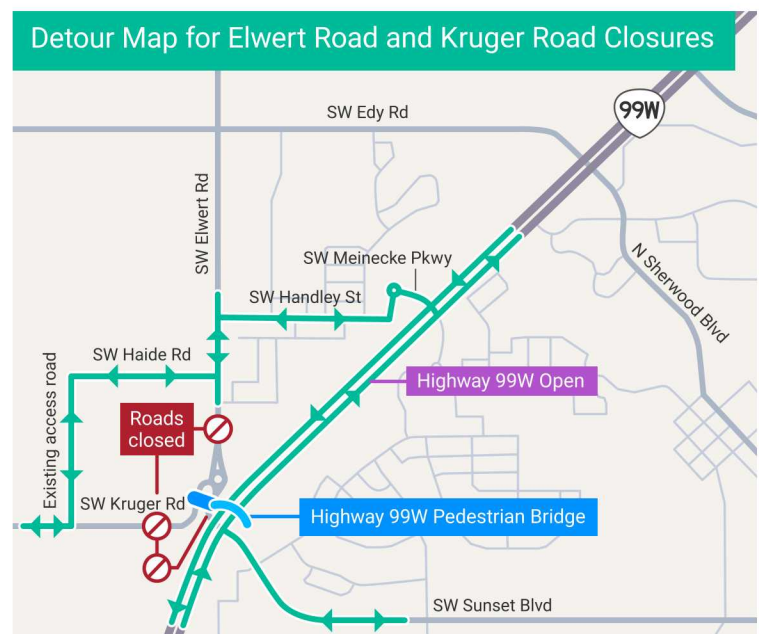
SW Elwert Road will be closed from its intersection with 99W to SW Haide Road. SW Kruger Road will be closed from the temporary access road west of Sherwood High School to its terminus at the roundabout at Elwert Road.

- Both the northbound and southbound detours are: 99W to Meinecke Parkway to Handley Street to Elwert Road to Haide Road to Kruger Road.
- Hwy 99W will remain open.
- SW Sunset Boulevard will remain open.
- Local access to SW Orchard Hill Lane and the Sherwood Elks Lodge driveway will be provided via SW Elwert Road from the north.
- Local access to the properties south of SW Kruger Road and east of the detour will be provided via SW Kruger Road from the west.

Elwert Road and Kruger Road will be closed again for a weekend in late spring.

Crews will place the bridge arch span over Kruger Road and the inverted arch span over the stormwater pond between Elwert Road and Kruger Road.
