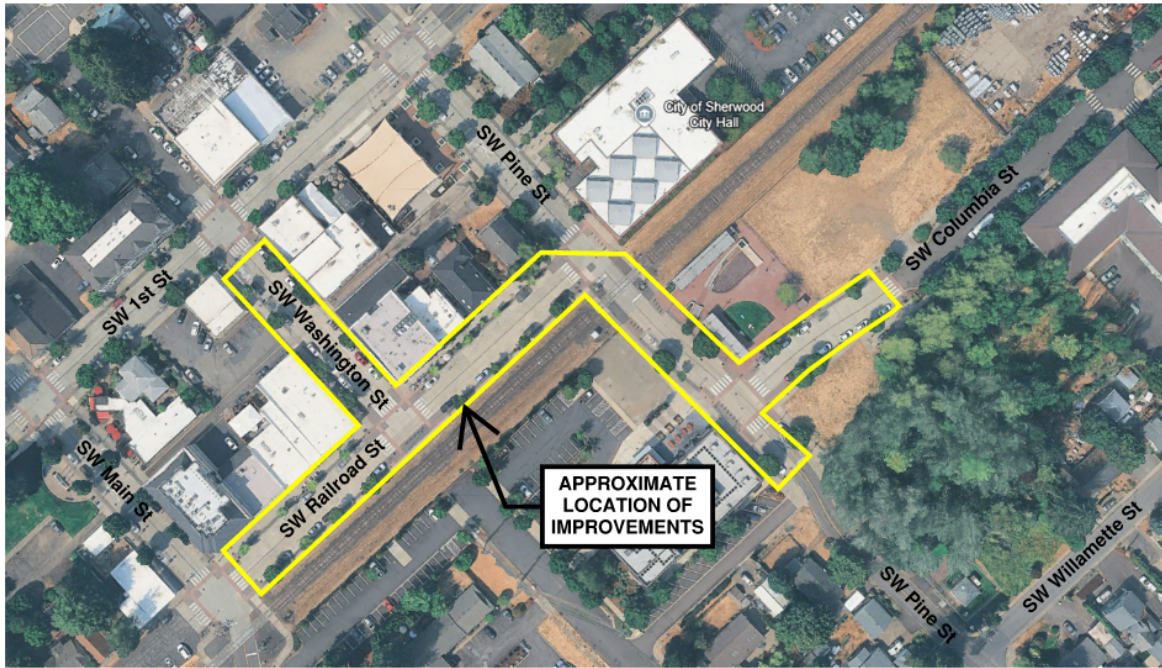
The City completing Phase 2 of the Downtown is repainting the light fixtures and amenities in Old Town. Please see attached map and project website (<https://www.sherwoodoregon.gov/engineering/project/downtown-streetscapes-phase-2-furnishing-repainting>) for details.

All City-owned amenities, including but not limited to lighting fixtures, poles, trash receptacles, benches, bike racks, and bollards will be repainted the same color of blue.

We anticipate this project to start in early September with an anticipated completion date of October 3, 2025.

Due to the location and nature of the work, outdoor seating may be impacted for short periods of time. Access to business is not anticipated to be impacted. It will be part of the contractor's work to inform neighbors when access will be limited. The contractor is responsible for protecting all public and private property from damage related to the work, including but not limited to overspray. This includes protection of windows, sidewalks, vehicles, signs and any other potentially affected areas. The City's inspector will be monitoring progress daily.
