10:00 AM – 2:00 PM

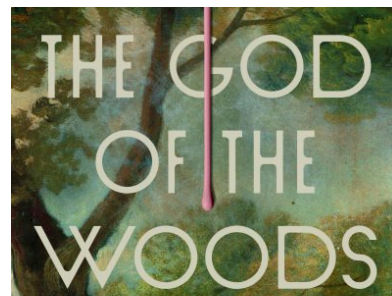

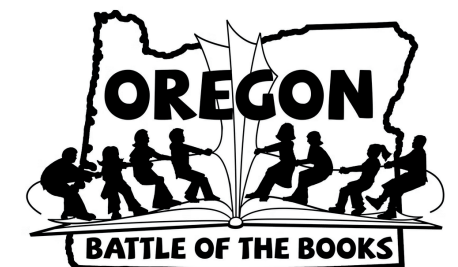
STEAM Saturdays are back! Drop in to work with 3D pens, Snap Circuits, robots and so much more. There is something for everyone at this station-based program. All ages.
