

**CITY OF SHERWOOD
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Sherwood City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at Sherwood City Hall, 22560 SW Pine Street, Sherwood, Oregon.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider a request to vacate two public access easements located north of the intersection of SW Oregon Street and SW Lower Roy Street (Washington County Assessor's Map 2S129DC, Tax Lot 1600). The easements were recorded as Washington County Document Nos. 2010-53593 and 2010-53594 and collectively encompass approximately 10,000 to 11,326 square feet of land extending from the SW Oregon Street frontage northward to the shared property line with Tax Lots 600 and 602.

The proposed vacation would remove access rights for the general public while retaining reciprocal access and utility easement rights between the abutting property owners. Following the vacation, the area will be used for private driveway access serving the adjacent properties.

At the hearing, the City Council will receive testimony and consider whether the proposed vacation is consistent with applicable provisions of the Sherwood Municipal Code and Oregon Revised Statutes. Any interested person may appear and be heard. Written testimony may be submitted to planning@sherwoodoregon.gov
