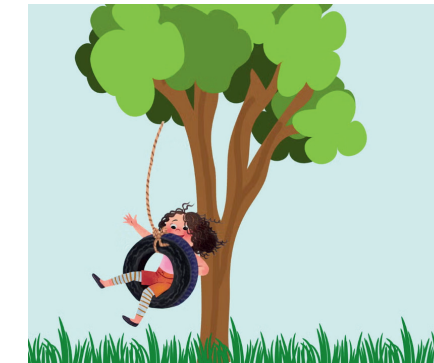
Youth Summer Reading
