**Issue:**

Should the URA Board of Directors accept the Cultural Arts Commission's recommendation for the Pedestrian Bridge Medallion Artwork?

**Background:**

Public art was incorporated into the design of the Highway 99W Pedestrian Bridge to create a landmark that reflects Sherwood's unique identity. While the bridge has been completed and is in use, the medallion component of the project was intentionally deferred to allow sufficient time for a thoughtful design process.

Working collaboratively with Oregon artist Deann Garcia, the Sherwood Cultural Arts Commission developed a series of eight medallions that complement the existing artistic elements of the bridge. The designs were informed by community input and are centered on the theme "**Who Walked Here?**"--illustrating the relationship between Sherwood's natural environment, its history, and the people who have shaped the community. Together, the eight medallions tell the story of Sherwood through artwork integrated into the bridge.

The proposed designs were presented during the City Council work session on June 16, 2026. Following Council discussion and feedback, the Cultural Arts Commission finalized its recommendation and now requests the URA Board acceptance of the artwork so fabrication and installation may proceed.

**Financial Impacts:**

Funding for fabrication and installation of the medallions is included within the approved Pedestrian Bridge project budget. Approval of this recommendation does not require additional appropriations.

**Recommendation:**

Approve URA Resolution 2026-002, Accepting the Cultural Arts Commission's Recommendation for the Pedestrian Bridge Medallion Artwork.





## URA RESOLUTION 2026-002

### ACCEPTING THE CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION FOR THE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE MEDALLION ARTWORK

**WHEREAS**, the Sherwood Urban Renewal Agency is responsible for the Sherwood Pedestrian Bridge project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sherwood Cultural Arts Commission was tasked with working with an artist to develop medallion artwork for the Sherwood Pedestrian Bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sherwood Cultural Arts Commission collaborated with artist Deann Garcia and members of the community to develop the recommended medallion designs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cultural Arts Commission recommends the attached artwork, consisting of eight medallion designs that complement the bridge's existing artistic features and celebrate Sherwood's history, culture, and natural environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council reviewed the proposed artwork during its June 16, 2026, work session, and the Cultural Arts Commission recommends approval of the final artwork.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY BOARD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Agency Board accepts the recommendation of the Sherwood Cultural Arts Commission for the Sherwood Pedestrian Bridge medallion artwork, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval and adoption.

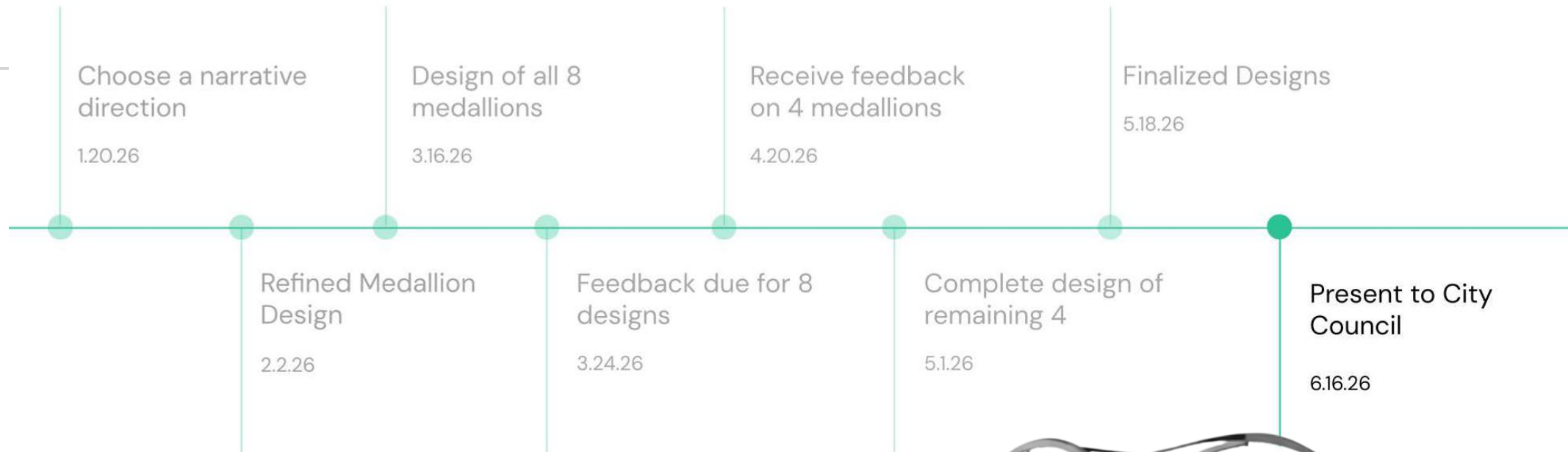

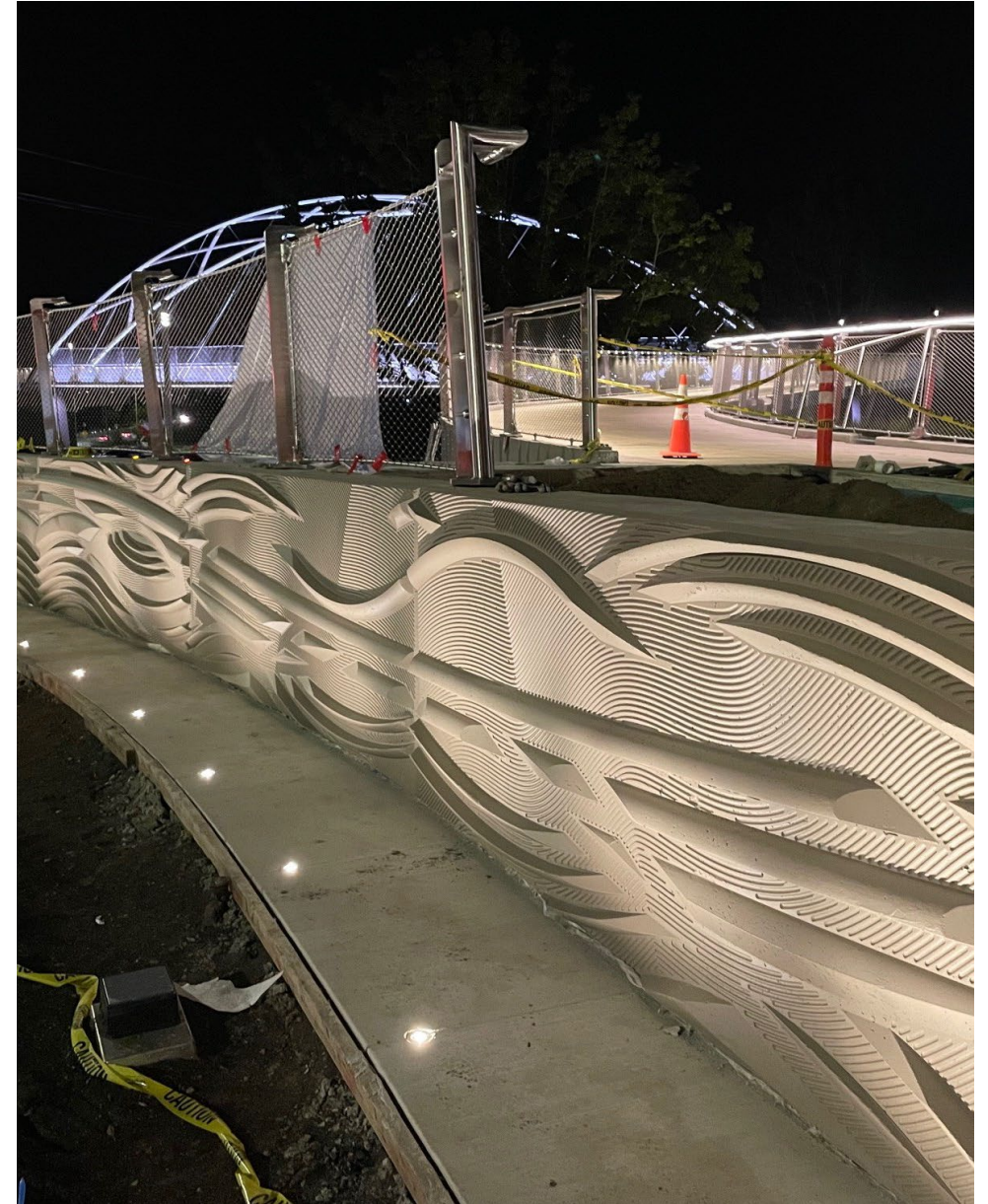
This series weaves together human history and the natural world, illustrating how the story of Sherwood is inseparable from its environment.

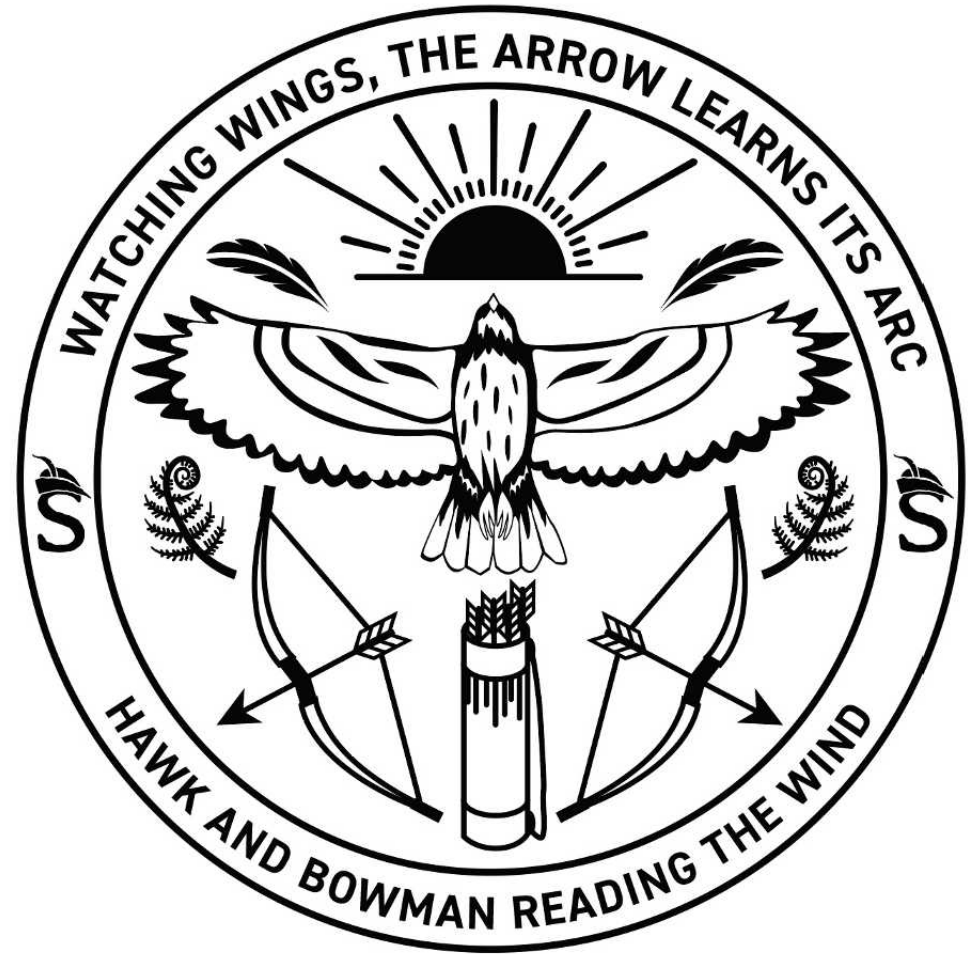
Anchoring medallion on west end of bridge



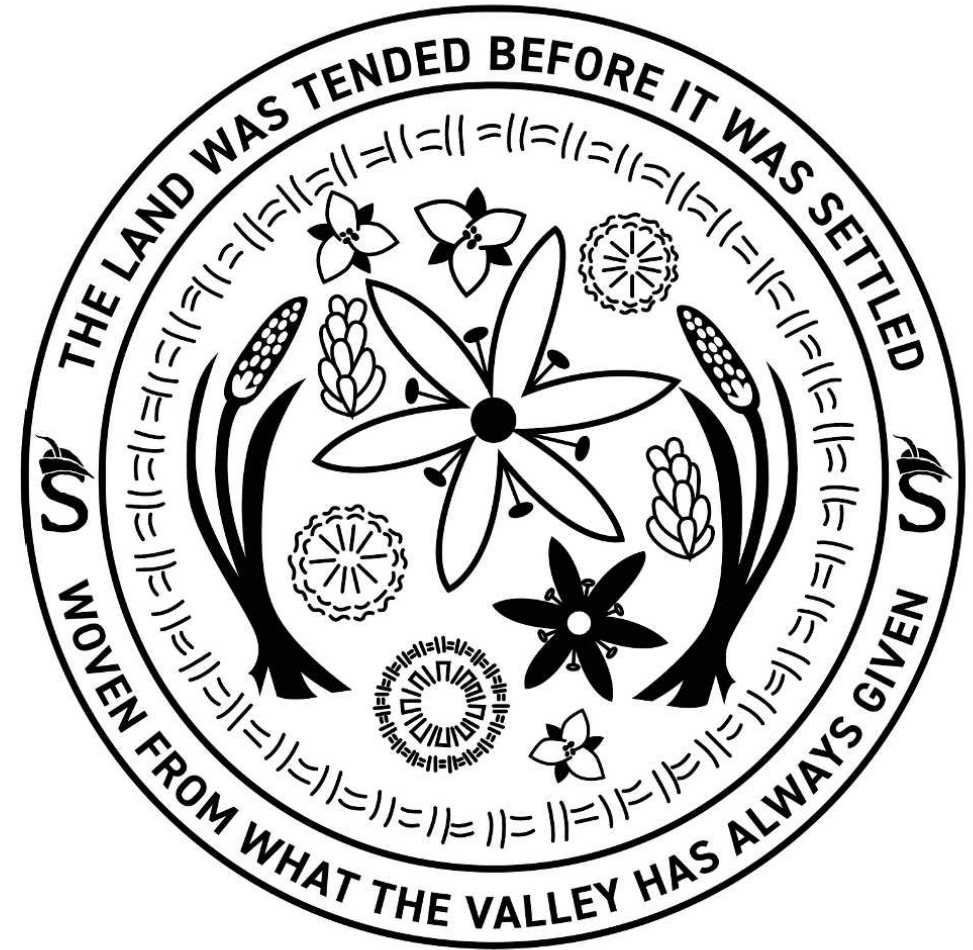

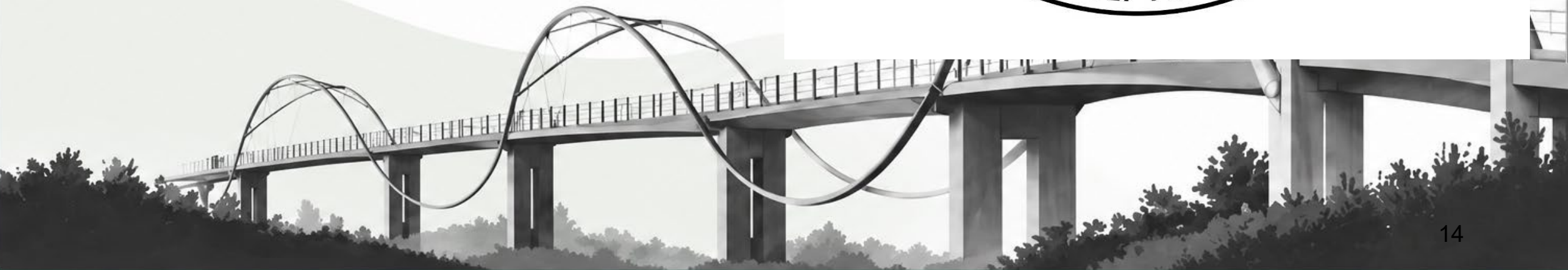
Anchoring medallion on east side of bridge

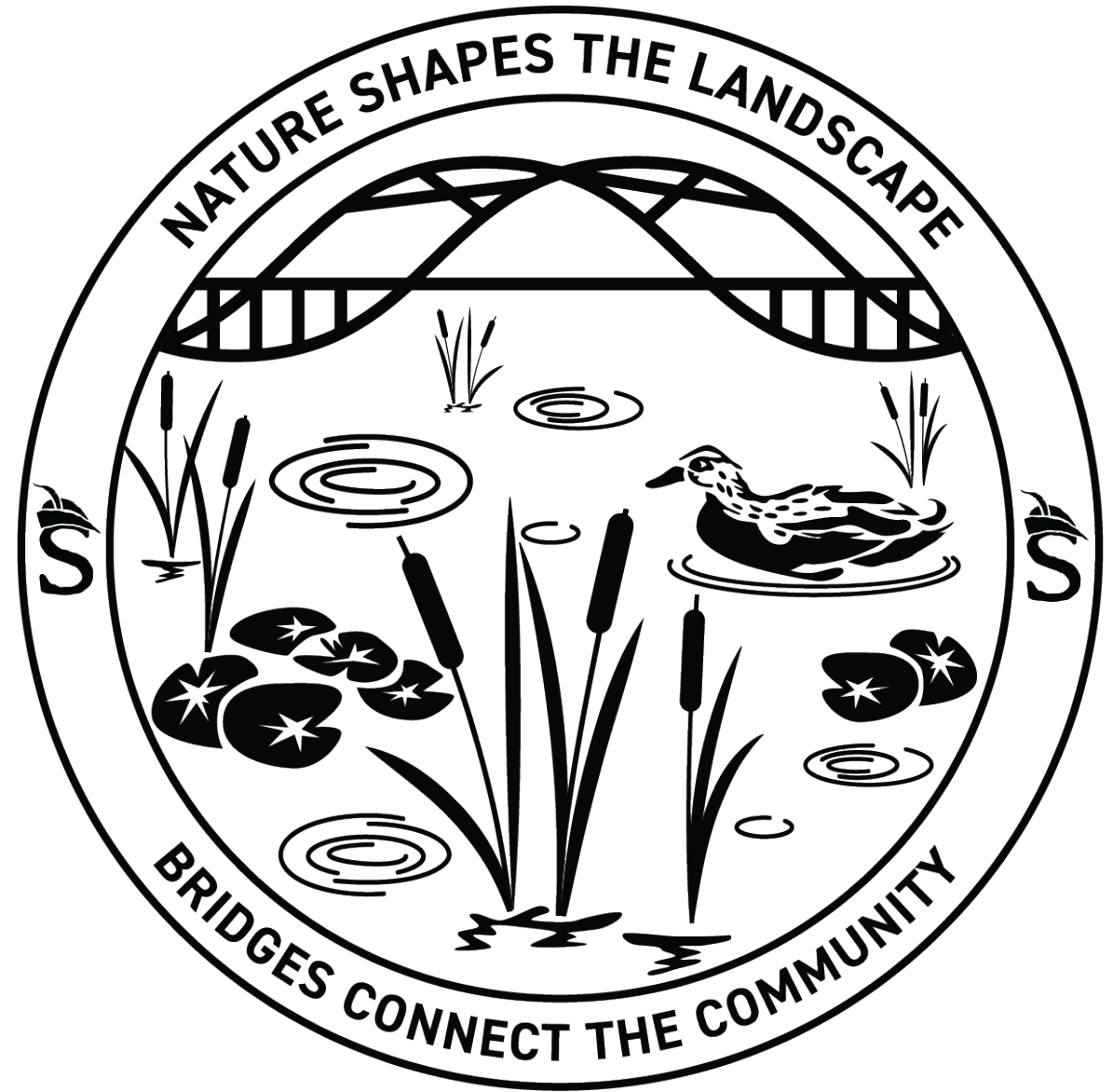
